

TE Sanctions Policy

TE Connectivity, including its U.S. and non-US subsidiaries, will not do business in, or with, NORTH KOREA, SYRIA, IRAN and CUBA, including any entities or persons in those countries, even if such transactions are currently lawful and comply with US, EU and other laws. This policy decision reflects TE Connectivity's assessment of the current risks and business opportunities to our Company as a whole based on legal and regulatory requirements, our reputation, and our obligations as a corporate citizen.

As a result, TE Connectivity legal entities, wherever they are located, should not accept any business (including new orders from existing customers or the submission of new bids) in and with these countries absent a specific OFAC license.

TE Connectivity companies comply with US, EU and other international trade laws and will continue to comply with all such laws. This position statement may be amended as necessary in response to subsequent changes in law.
